# Technology Toolkit

For the last couple of years and even before, people have less and less hard currencies in their pockets/wallets/purses, so how do we facilitate cash donation activities?

During the pandemic, organizations were asking people to use debit cards or credit cards. As we come out of the pandemic, we can project that the trend of people having little or no hard currencies in pocket will continue.

What are alternative options? There are new potential solutions involving touchless giving devices.

## **Tiptap**

Tiptap is a touchless giving option using a wireless receiver that can be mounted or placed anywhere and donations can be made using debit card, credit card or digital wallet. Each pocket-sized unit functions as an autonomous Point of Sale (POS) system with a pre-set dollar amount, enabling contactless transactions without additional equipment or complicated back-end technology. Moneris securely processes the transactions to give donors peace of mind.
