INTRODUCTION

In the Far North we support the Inuit, the indigenous people of the Arctic. Our activities are concentrated in Kuujjuaq and in the villages of the region. We work with the organization “Ippigusugiursavik Supervised House”, our local partner headquartered in Kuujjuaq.



We are developing a social economy project to enable the partner organization to generate additional income which would allow it to ensure the continuity of services to people experiencing poverty.

This approach allowed us to support a thrift store that we have been supplying from Montreal for more than five years.

This report summarises the results of our work in 2024.

SUPPLYING THE THRIFT STORE IN 2024

During the year 2024, we sent **1102 kg or 1.102 tonnes** of clothing.

In addition to clothing, we also shipped household appliances and furniture, details of which are shown in the table below:



ESTIMATED COSTS

The total cost, including salaries, is CAD **\$76,367.75**.

The estimated budget for two 40-foot containers, including work organisation, salaries, monitoring and evaluation, is **\$127,115**. The budget was submitted to National on October 21, 2024.
