## Personal Encounter through Home Visit

- Always visit in pairs
- Focus on the person and having a conversation to understand need

Provide assistance

Thank the person for inviting you into their home







## Personal Encounter through Outreach

- Always do outreach in pairs
- Outreach can involve visiting someone in a tent or wherever they are staying on the street



- Focus on the person and listening to what they want to share
- Provide assistance needed







### Personal Encounter at SSVP Thrift Store

- People in need visit SSVP Thrift Store
- SSVP Stores provide assistance with clothing, furniture & household necessities
- SSVP Stores offer food assistance & hygiene items
- SSVP Stores offer clothing & blanket to those who are unhoused
- Focus on the person and listening to their need









- People in need visit food bank / pantry
- Boxes may be pre-packaged with food items depending on number of people in family
- Focus on the person and listening to their need
- Provide food assistance

- How do you overcome your emotions/feelings at that point in time?







## Concluding Personal Encounter

• What do I say?

• What do I do?

• Thank them for their time.







#### After Personal Encounter

#### Post personal encounter recap and reporting

- How did you feel about the encounter?
- What information do you retain? Only collect necessary information.
- Pray for the individual / family helped.
- Share personal encounter stories at your conference meeting, especially those that were particularly difficult or rewarding.







## **Challenging Situations**

- If Jesus was with you on the personal encounter, how would he handle the situation?
- What would he say?
- What would he ask?
- Let this guide you through any challenging moments.







## What was Accomplished

- The individual/family benefited financially/materially from your encounter.
- What other gifts did you leave behind?
- How did the personal encounter strengthen your spiritual relationship?
