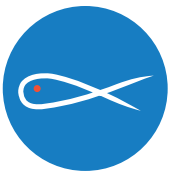

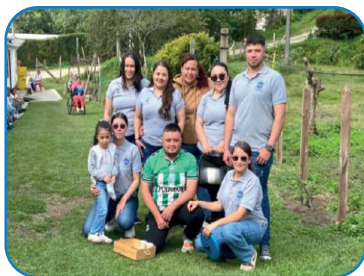


The SSVP has been providing "compassion in action" in Canada for 180 years, and our efforts grow more impactful each year.
